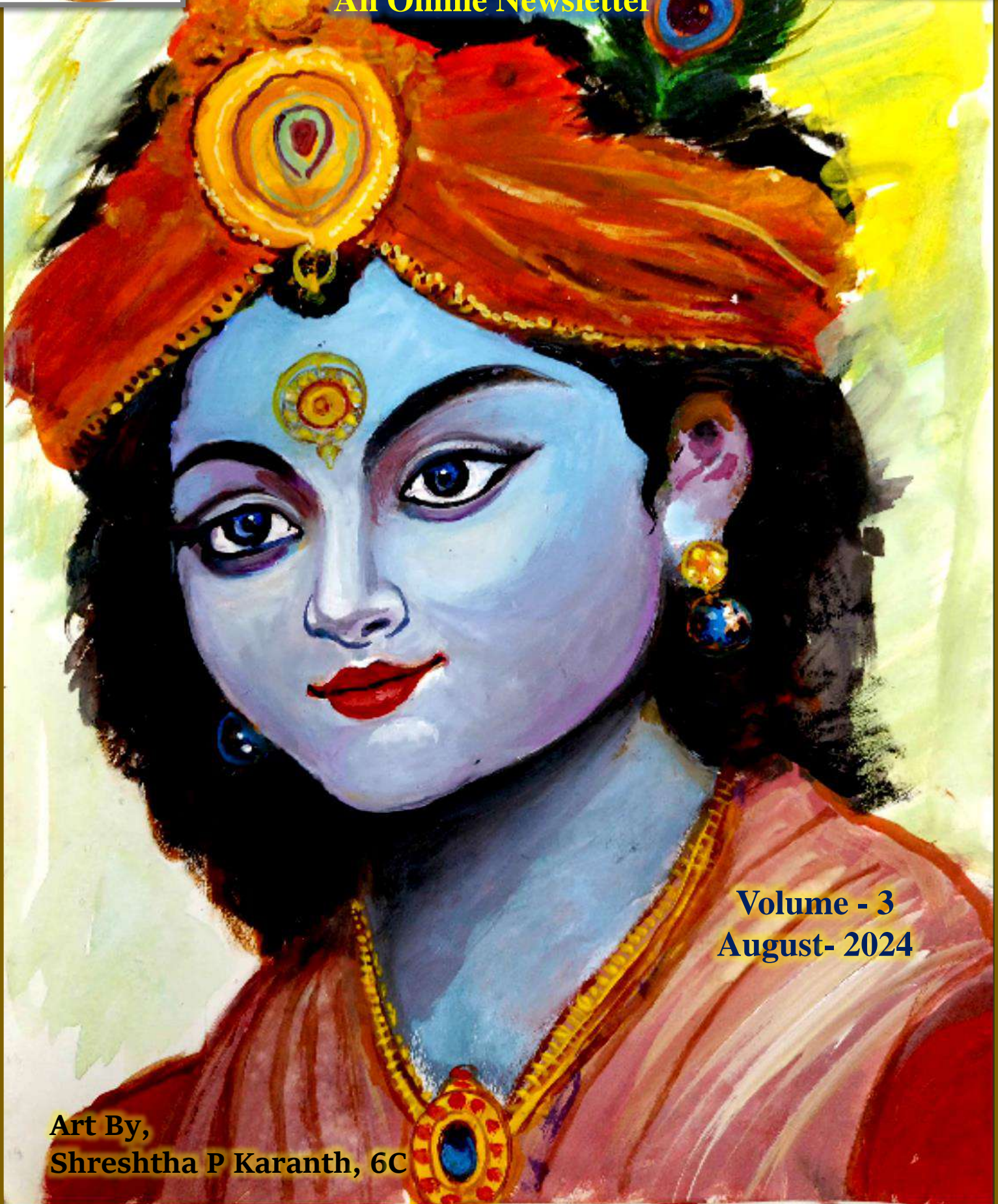

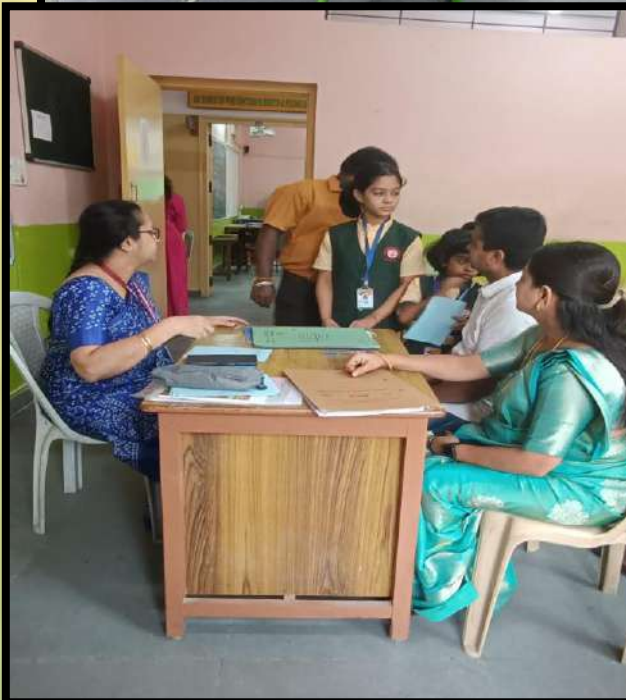

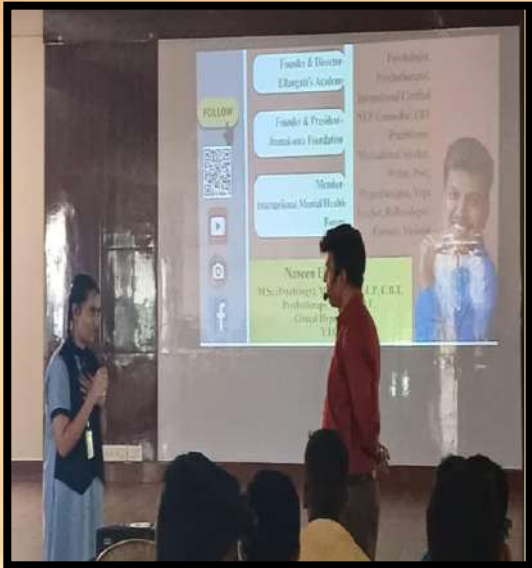
Parent – Teacher Meeting

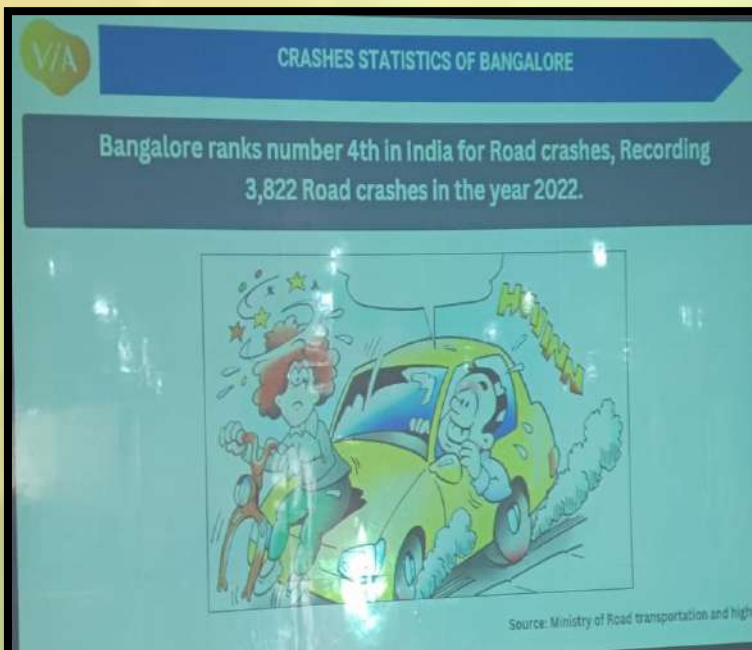
Sanskrit Day Celebration

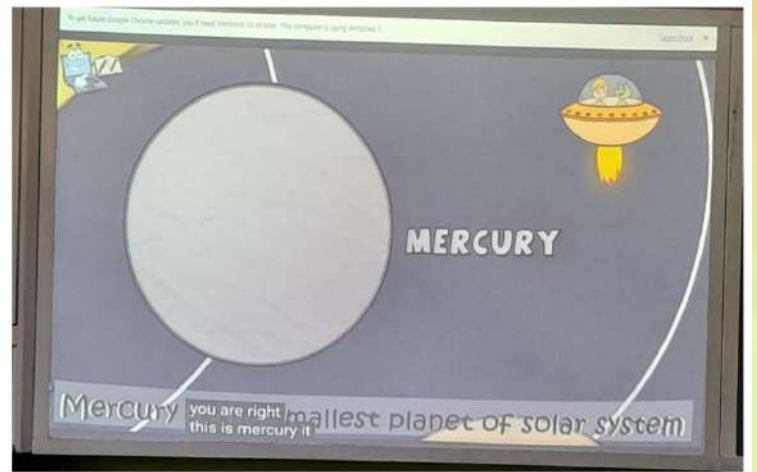


National Space Day

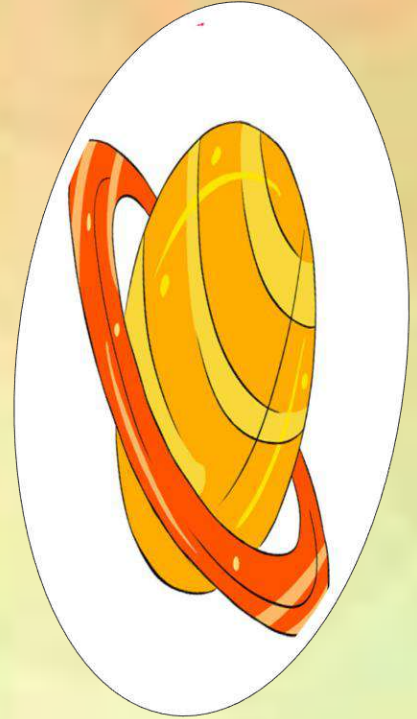

- Dr. Sudha Murthy is an Indian educator, author, philanthropist, entrepreneur and the first woman in India to study mechanical and electronics engineering. She is one of the elected members who has been nominated to Rajya Sabha under the field of social work and Education.
- During her graduation, she was the only one female student without having a companion in her engineering college. But she didn't give up. She focused on her studies and secured a gold medal. At the young age of 10, Sudha mam discovered the power of stories by attributing her passion for telling stories.
- Now she has written more than 25 books in English, and as well as in Kannada. Also, she secured another gold medal by completing her post-graduation in Computer Science from the Indian Institute of Science. Sudha mam wrote a postcard to the Chairman of TELCO and complained about the gender bias in the company. After this, she became the first female engineer in TELCO company. This shows her courage and equality.
- Even in her busy schedule, she is also a visiting professor at the Bengaluru University, to share her thoughts with the youngsters. She helped poor students in education.
- Sudha mam's character can be best described as empathetic, down-to-earth, humble, simple, perseverant and committed to education. Also, she has spiritual character as now in Mantralaya, she is selling vegetables to the people for Raghavendra Swamy's Seva. Even though she has done so many achievements and travelled across so many countries, she respects and doesn't forget her Indian culture.
- Some personalities inspire many. It is not enough to just admire and worship such a personality, we should follow their path and be a role model for others. Here by, we must be a citizen who contributes to the country.

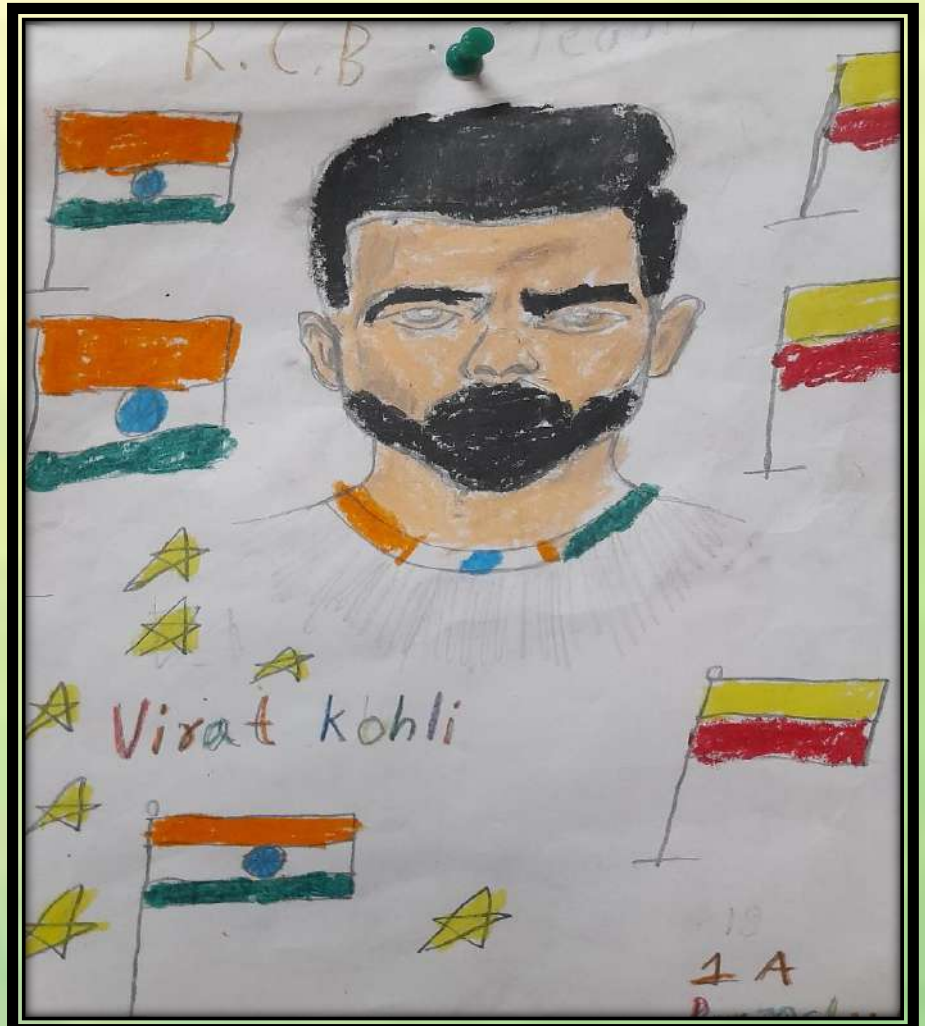

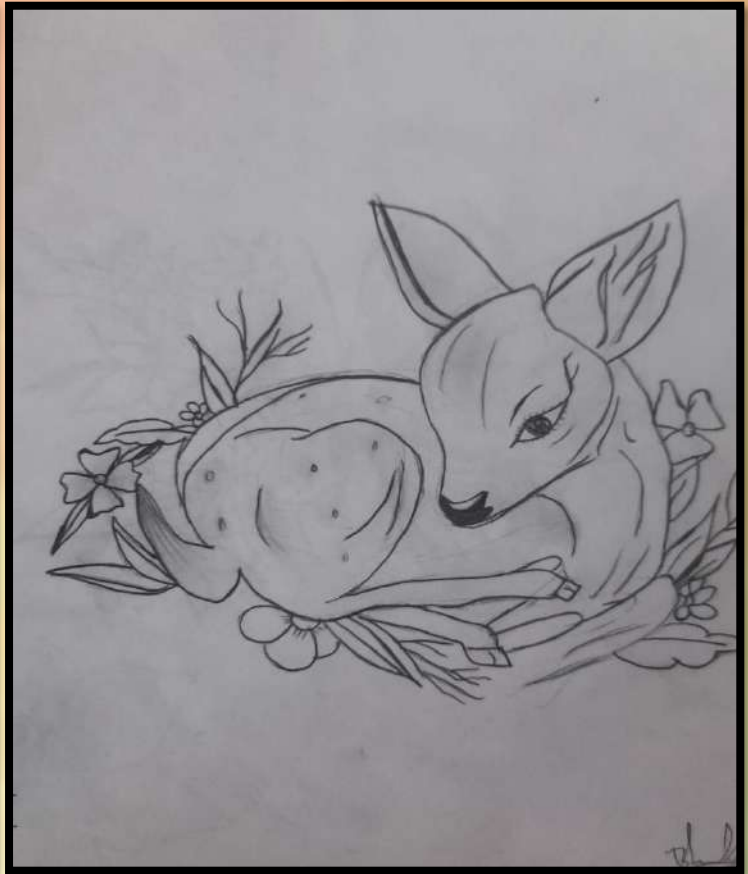

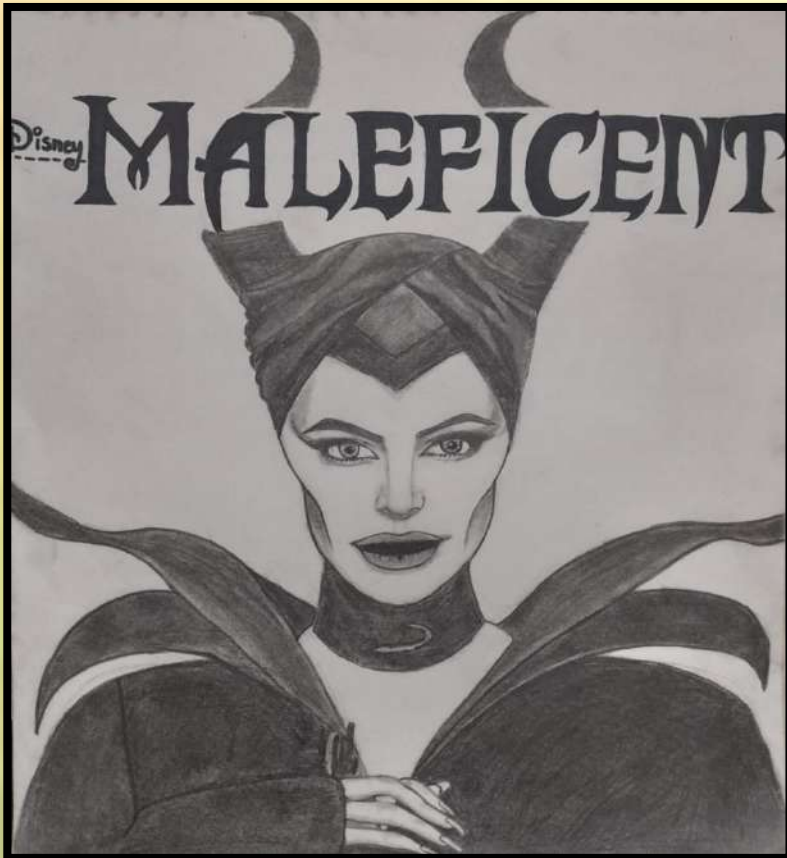
