



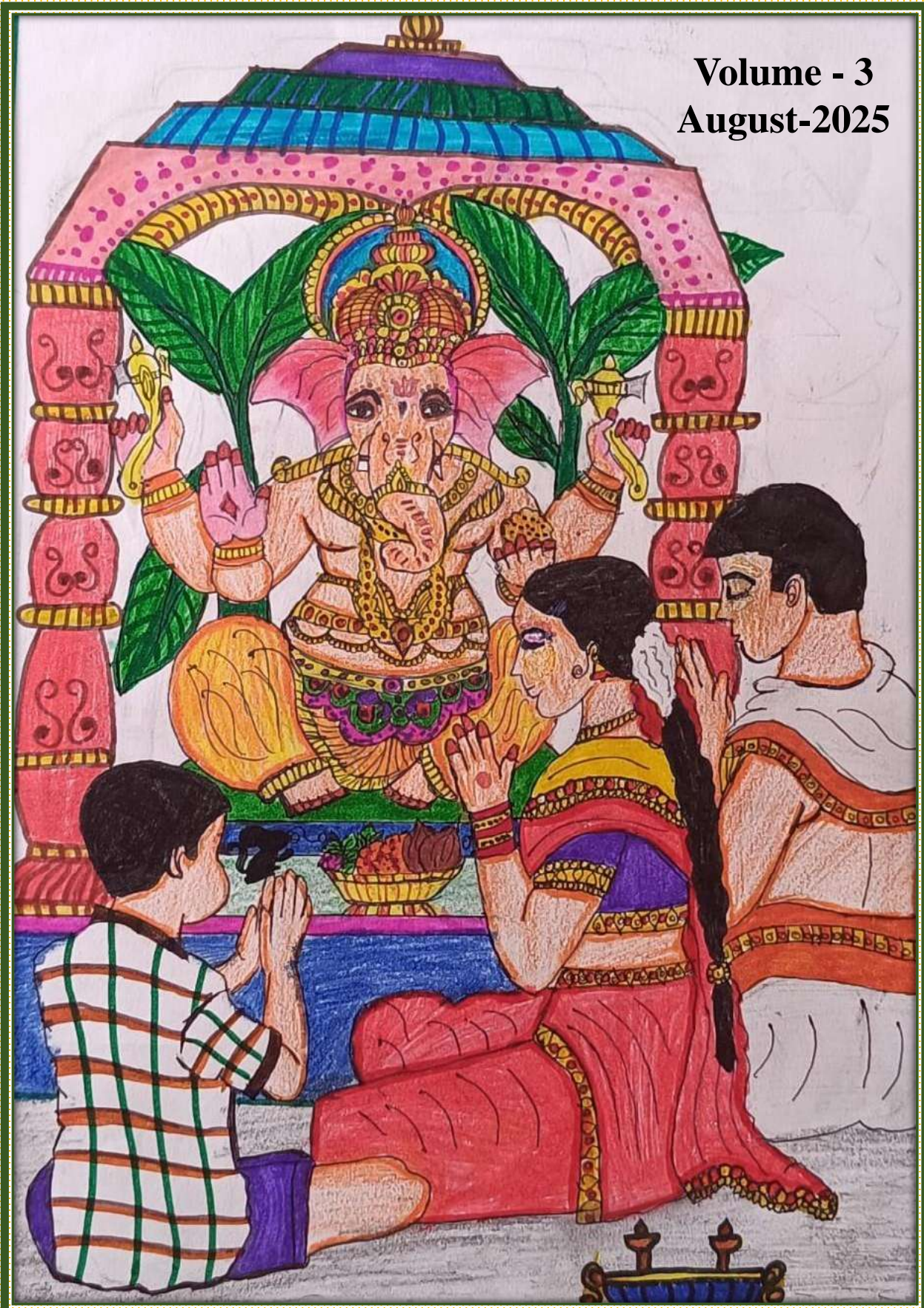

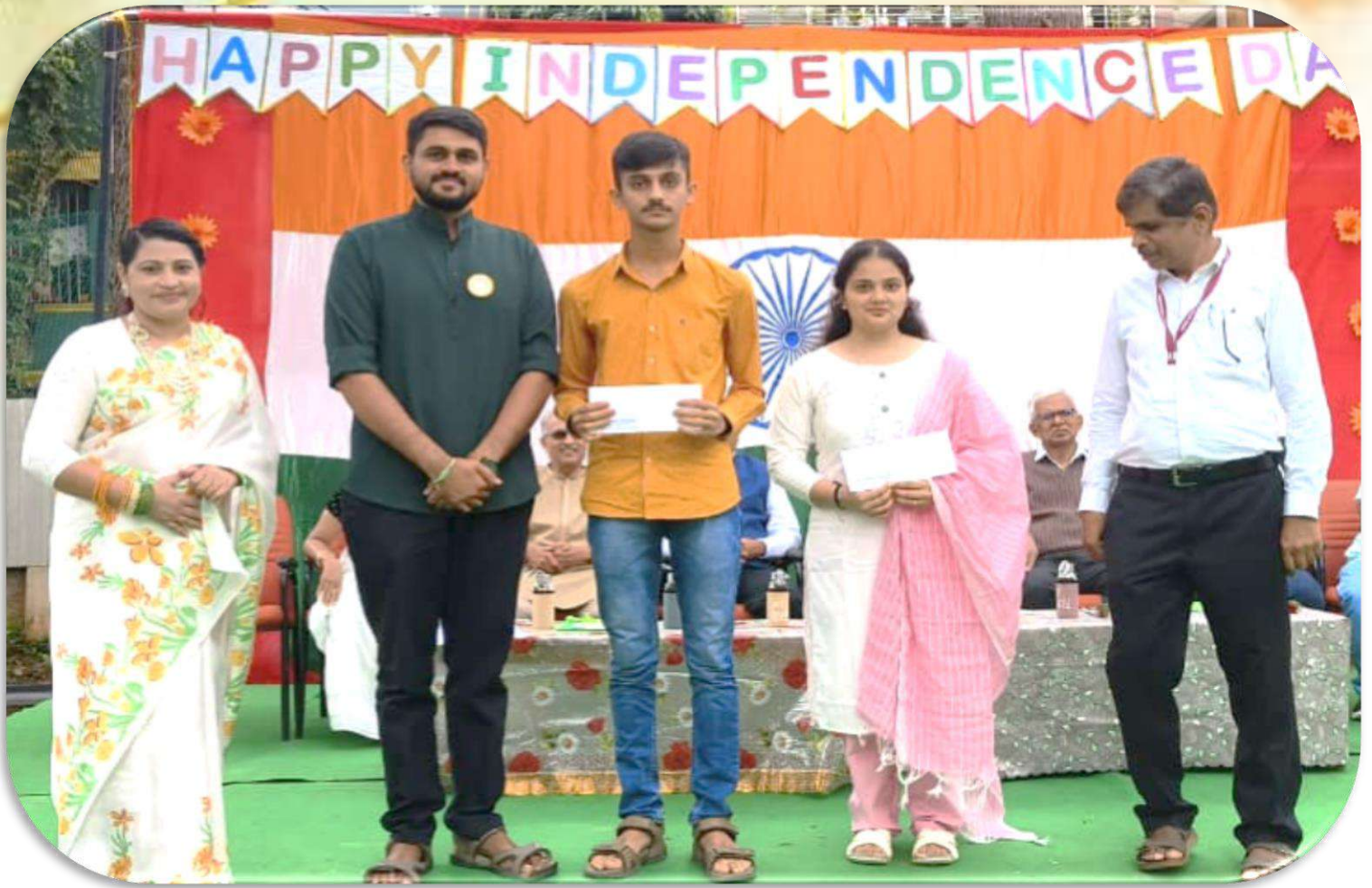












# NATIONAL SPACE DAY

Simple habits like turning off taps immediately after washing hands can save litres of water every day. Protecting our water starts with small, mindful actions at school and beyond.

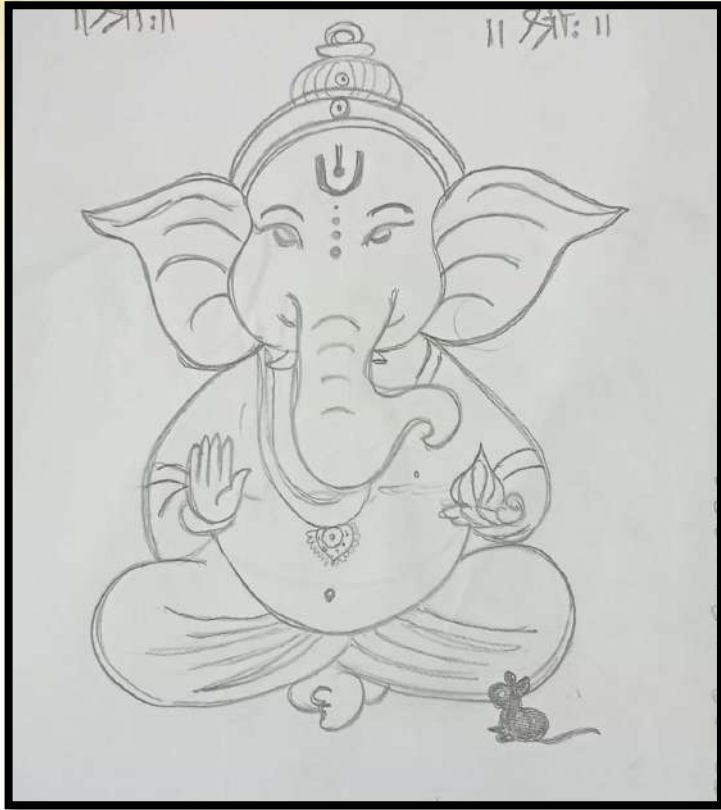
