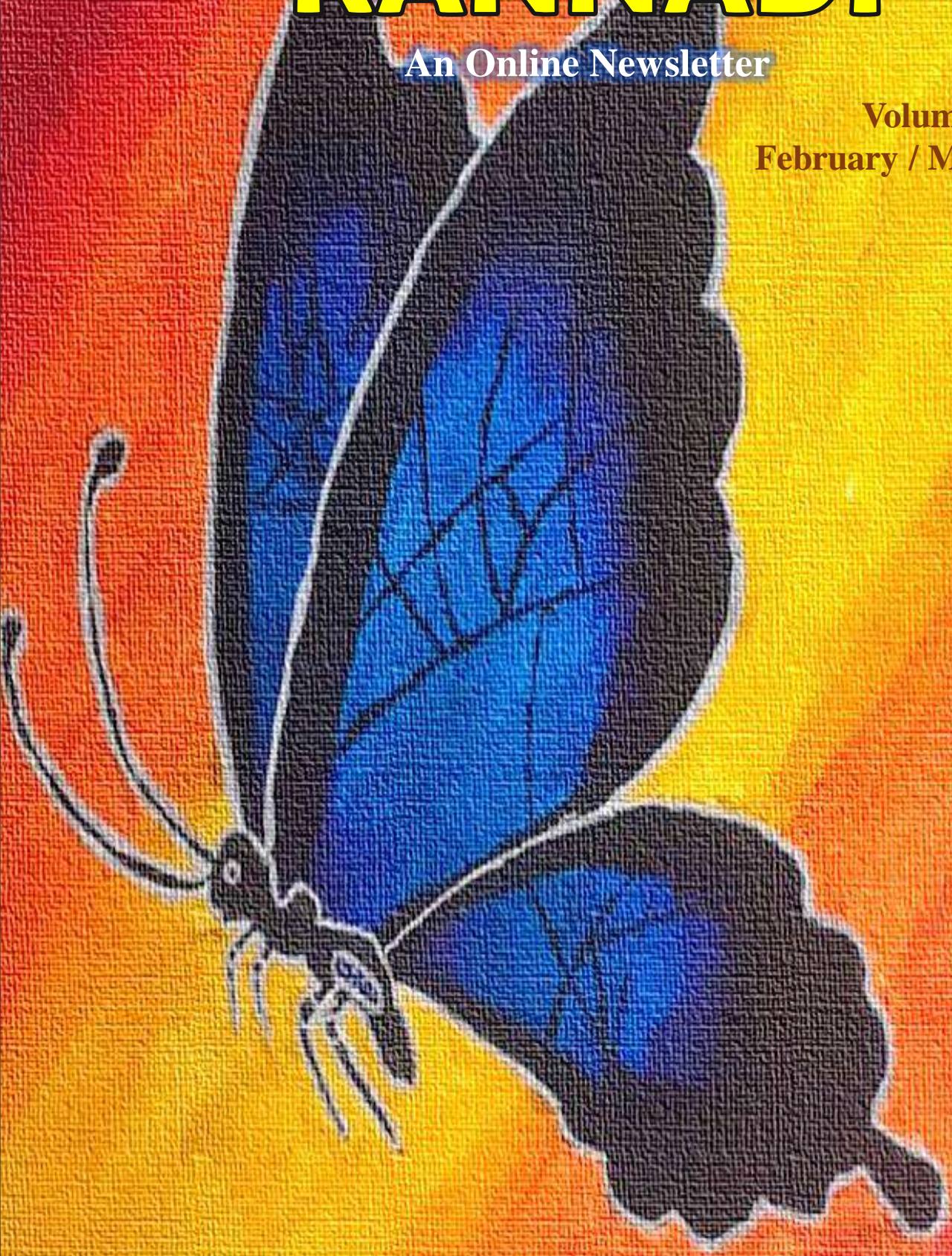

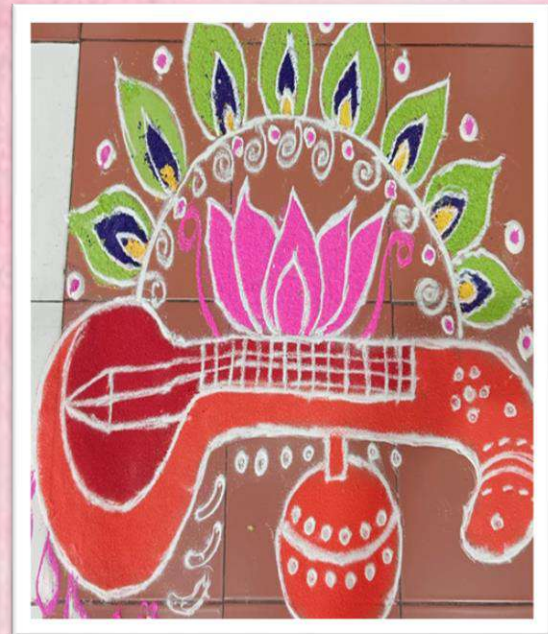
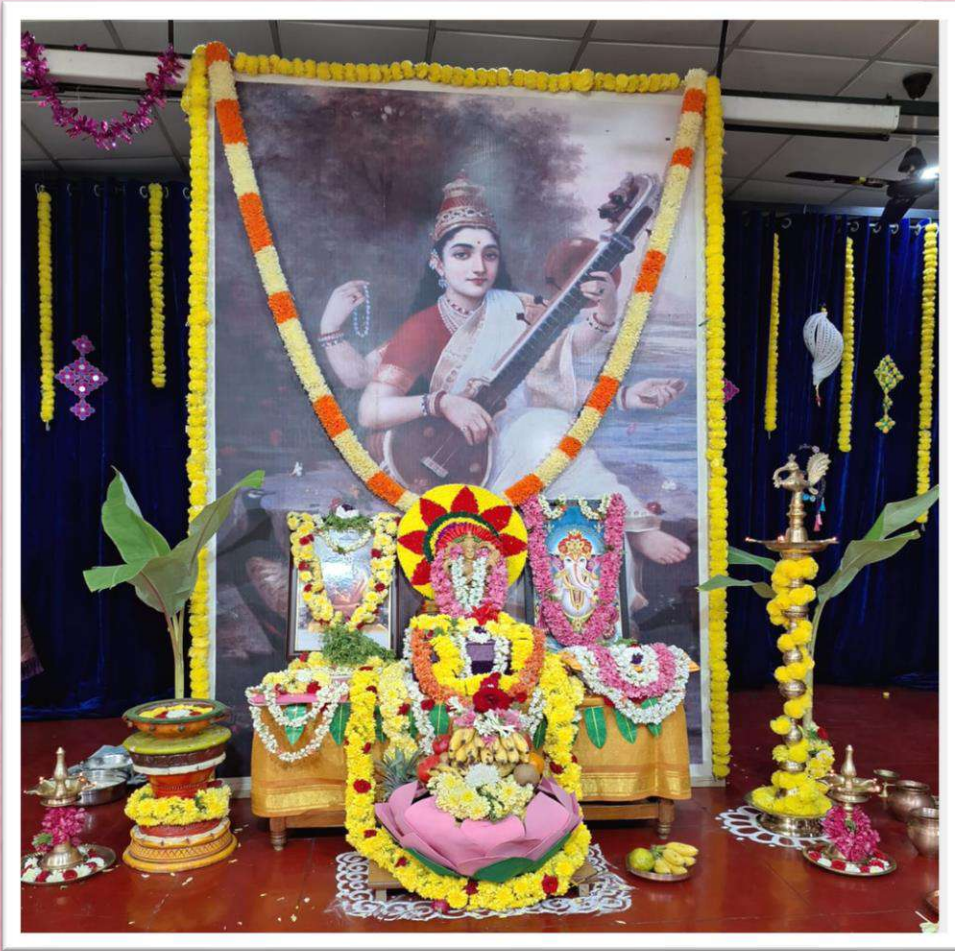
Zee Kannada visit to our school

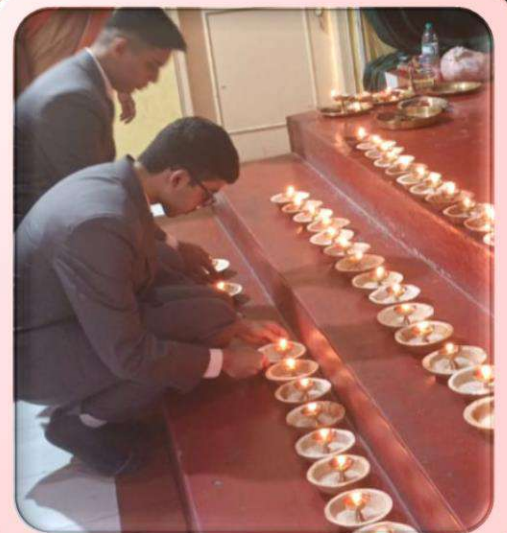
Disha Drushti

Health and Hygiene session was conducted for girls of class 6 to 9 on 8th February 2024 by Smt. Shruti.



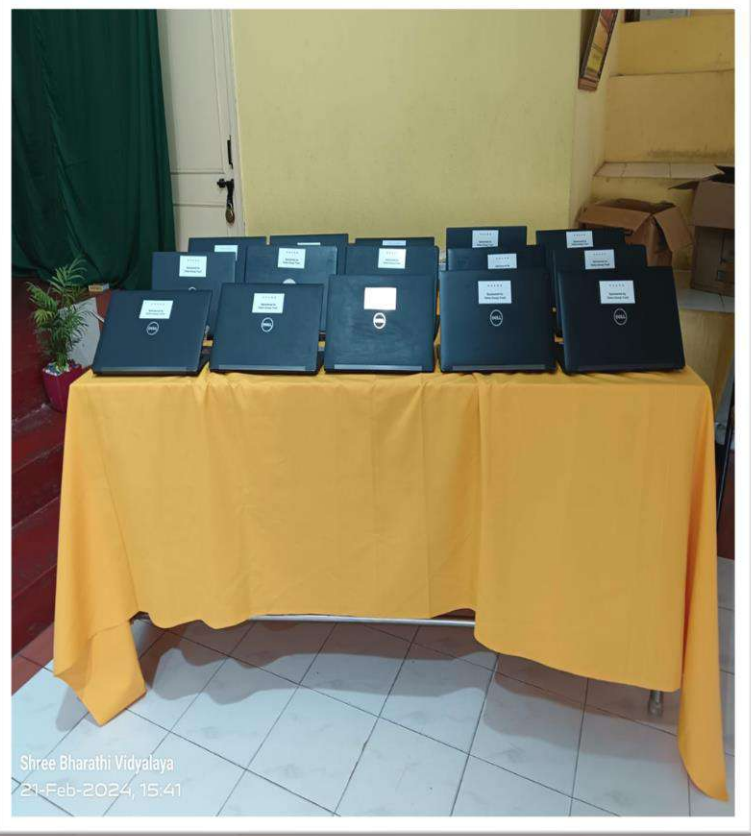
AI and Robotics Workshop

World Thinking Day and Scout Founder's Day

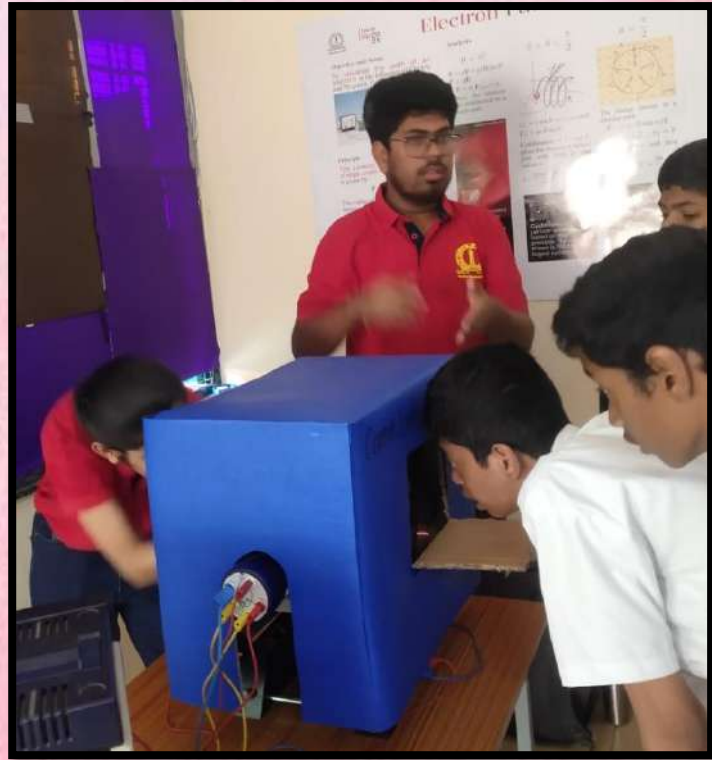

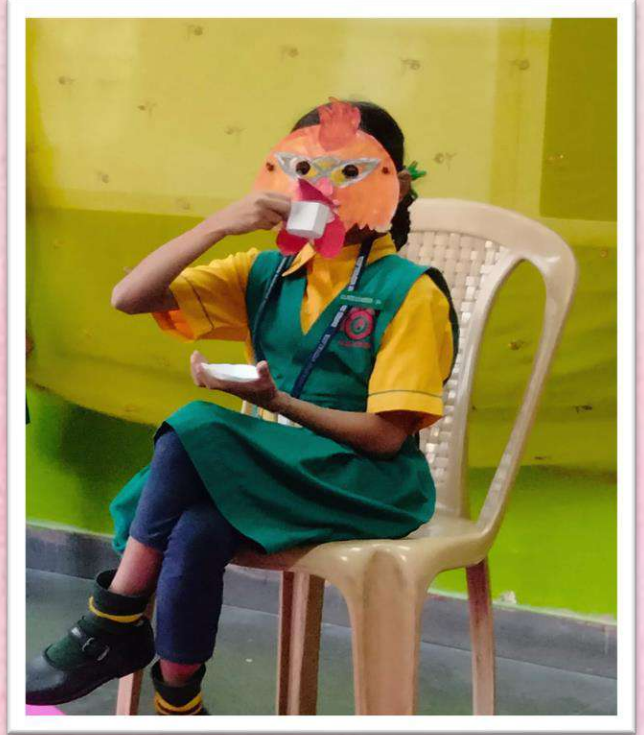

Students' Corner

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj: The Legendary Maratha King

Shivaji Maharaj was born into the Bhosale clan of the Maratha Empire, which was the part of the Deccan Sultanates. From an early age, he exhibited exceptional leadership qualities and a deep sense of patriotism. Influenced by his mother Jijabai and inspired by the tales of valour from the great Hindu epics, Shivaji Maharaj developed a strong sense of duty towards his people and a vision of establishing Hindavi Swaraj.

At the young age of 16, Shivaji Maharaj embarked on his mission to liberate the region from the oppressive Mughal and Bijapur Sultanates. He skilfully used Guerrilla warfare tactics, surprise attacks and strategic alliances to challenge the dominant powers and gradually expand his territory. By establishing a network of forts and a disciplined army known as Maratha Navy, Shivaji Maharaj successfully carved out an independent kingdom.

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was not only a brilliant military strategist but also a visionary administrator. He implemented several reforms to ensure efficient governance and upliftment of his subjects. Shivaji Maharaj introduced a well-structured administrative system with a council of ministers known as the Ashta Pradhan Mandal. Each minister was responsible for a specific department such as revenue, finance justice and defence.

To maintain law and order, he devised a code of ethics known as the “Hindavi Swarajya Diwas”, which emphasized justice, religious tolerance and protection of women and children. Shivaji Maharaj also recognised the importance of maritime power and established a strong naval force to protect the coastal regions from foreign invasions.

Chattrapati Shivaji Maharaj's legacy extends far beyond his military conquests. He was a staunch advocate of religious freedom, promoting harmony among different faiths. Despite being a devout Hindu, he treated people of all religions with respect and granted them religious freedom. Shivaji Maharaj's administration was known for its inclusive policy, whereby people of different castes and backgrounds were given equal opportunities in the administration and the military.

His efficient revenue system known as the "Chauth" and "Sardeshmukhi", ensured a steady income for the state while alleviating the burden on the common people. Shivaji Maharaj's emphasis on infrastructure development led to the construction of numerous forts, water reservoirs and marketplaces, fostering economic growth and improved living condition for his subjects.

Chattarapati Shivaji Maharaj's unwavering spirit of resistance against foreign rule and his ability to unite people from diverse backgrounds inspired generations of Indians and served as catalyst for the freedom struggle against British colonialism. His ideals of bravery, patriotism and good governance continue to resonate with the people of Maharashtra and entire nation.

The Pulwama Attack

The Pulwama attack, which occurred on February 14, 2019, in Jammu and Kashmir was a devastating terrorist attack that shook the entire nation to its core and sparked international conflict. Vehicles transporting security personnel were attacked by a suicide bomber, resulting in the loss of 40 soldiers and many other injured personnel.

The attack was carried out by a member of the Pakistan-based militant group Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM), which claimed responsibility for the heinous act. The suicide bomber, Adil Ahmad Dar, crashed an explosive filled vehicle into one of the buses in the convoy, leading to an explosion and causing extensive damage.

The Pulwama attack was one of the deadliest terrorist attacks in Kashmir in recent years and India responded strongly to the attack by withdrawing the Most Favored Nation (MFN) status accorded to Pakistan and launched diplomatic efforts to isolate Pakistan on the international level.

In response to the Pulwama attack, India also carried out a non-military airstrike on a training camp in Pakistan. The airstrike on 26th February 2019, was aimed at destroying the terrorist organization in the region and sending a message to Pakistan regarding its support for terrorism.

The Pulwama attack and its aftermath has security in the area and has severed friendly relation between India and Pakistan.

In conclusion, the Pulwama attack was an act of terrorism which took the lives of many soldiers.

This attack has brought back focus on the dangers of terrorism on the international level. Due to the attack, many countries are working towards the eradication of terrorism on the world scale.
