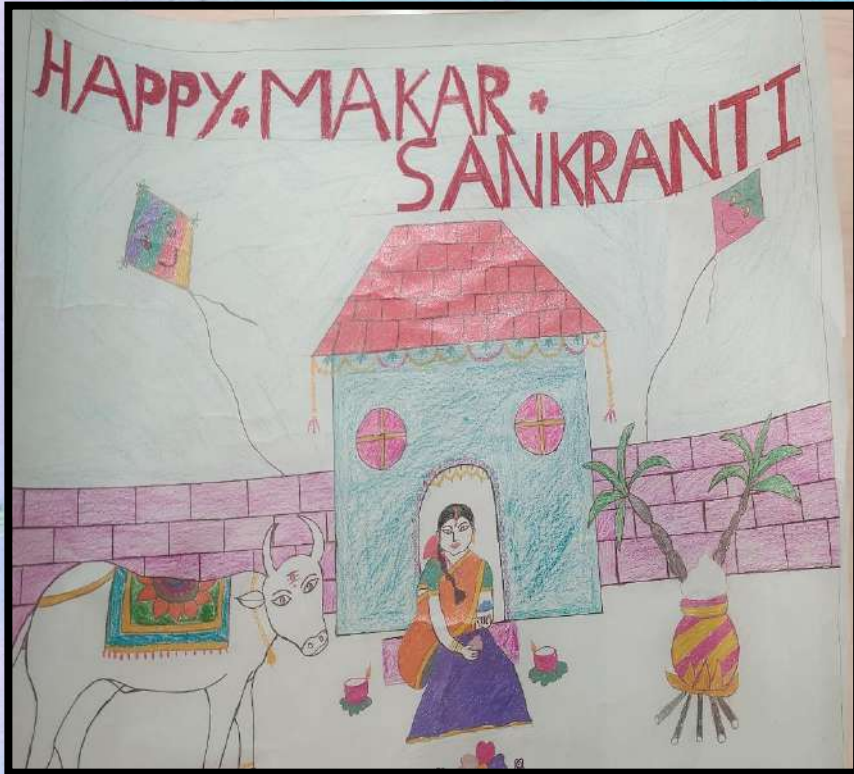

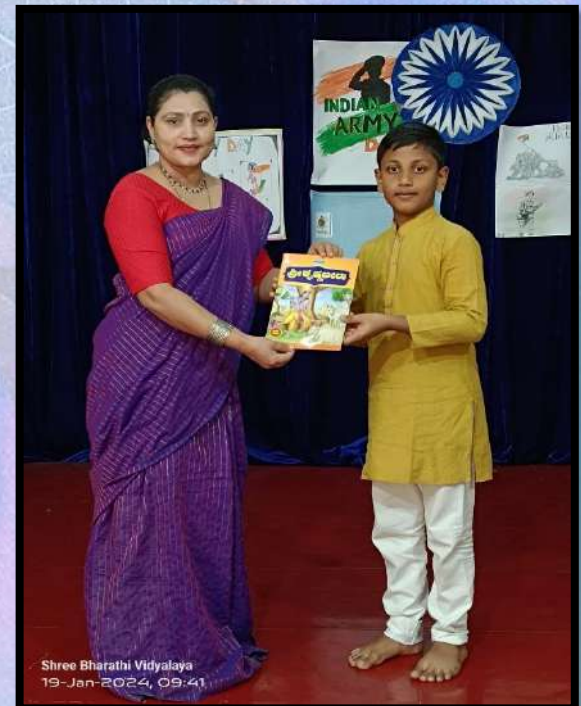

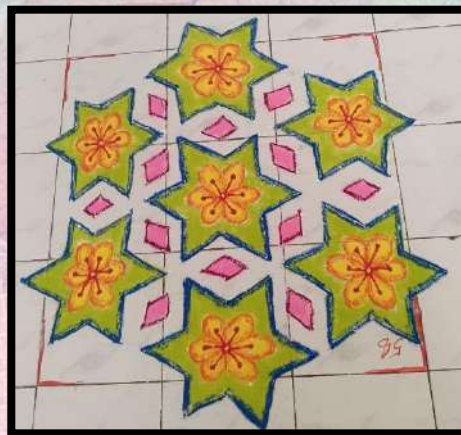

## Makara Sankranti

Makara Sankranti, also known as Uttarayan, is a vibrant and joyous festival celebrated in various parts of India, marking the transition of the sun into the zodiac sign of Capricorn. ## Swami Vivekananda

This is a famous quote said by Swami Vivekananda which even at present is true and gives chills once heard. “I am proud to belong to a religion which has taught the world not only tolerance and universal acceptance. We believe not only in universal tolerance but also accept all religions as true”.

“Act on the educated young men, bring them together, and organize them. Great things can be done by great sacrifices only. No selfishness, no name, no fame, yours or mine not my master’s even! My boys, my brave, noble good souls- to the wheel to the wheel put your shoulders.”

“ Whatever you think that you will be. If you think of yourselves as weak, weak you will be and if you think yourselves as strong, strong you will be.”

These are some of the famous quotes said by Swami Vivekananda which focus mainly on the development of the youth. Vivekananda won the heart of everyone by his incredible speech at Chicago by addressing the audience as sisters and brothers of America which shows that he promoted brotherhood at that time itself.

Next moving on to the life history of Swami Vivekananda. Swami Vivekananda was born on 12th January 1863 in the divine place in Kolkata and was named Narendranatha Dutta. He was the son of Sri Vishwanath and mother Bhuvaneshwari Devi. Narendra was a child of unquestioned expertise and intellectual capability who used to take grasp of all his school teachings at first sight. This excellence of his was recognized by his teachers and was thus named Shrutidhar by them.

Narendra was a spiritual person. All his spiritual quests were answered by Ramakrishna Paramahansa and he thus accepted him as his guru.

Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose also said, “Swamiji harmonized the East and the West, religion and science, past and present and that is why he is great”.

His establishment of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna mission is a sign of his guru bhakti and sacrifice. He was also the founder of Belur Math. He spread the message of divinity and the true aims of scriptures. This great patriotic monk of mother earth took his last breath on 4th July 1902 at Belur Math. Thus, we celebrate 12th January as the National Youth day.

It is observed to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda, one of the greatest philosophers and leaders of India.
