# SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CEREMONY HELD AT SHREE BHARATHI VIDYALAYA

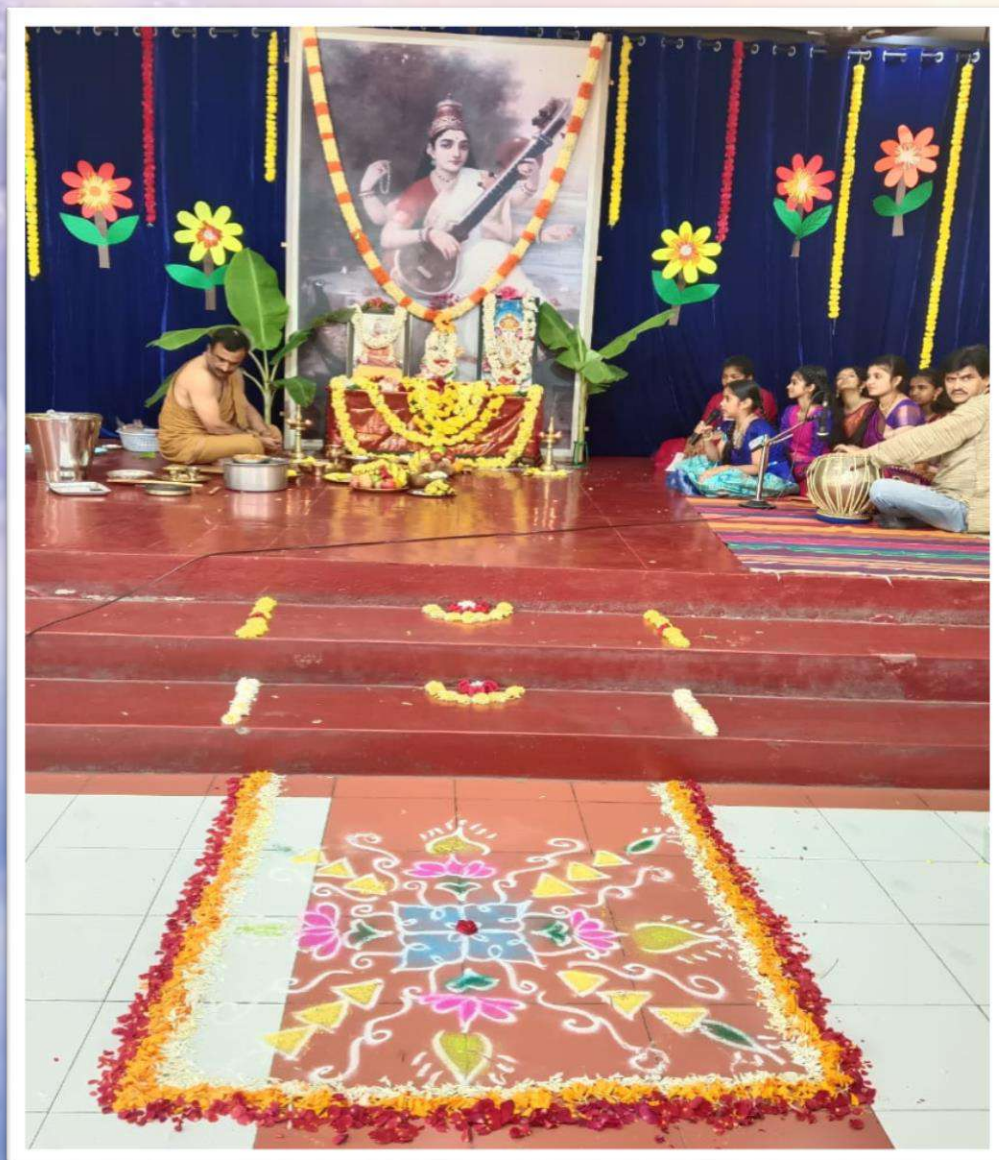
