



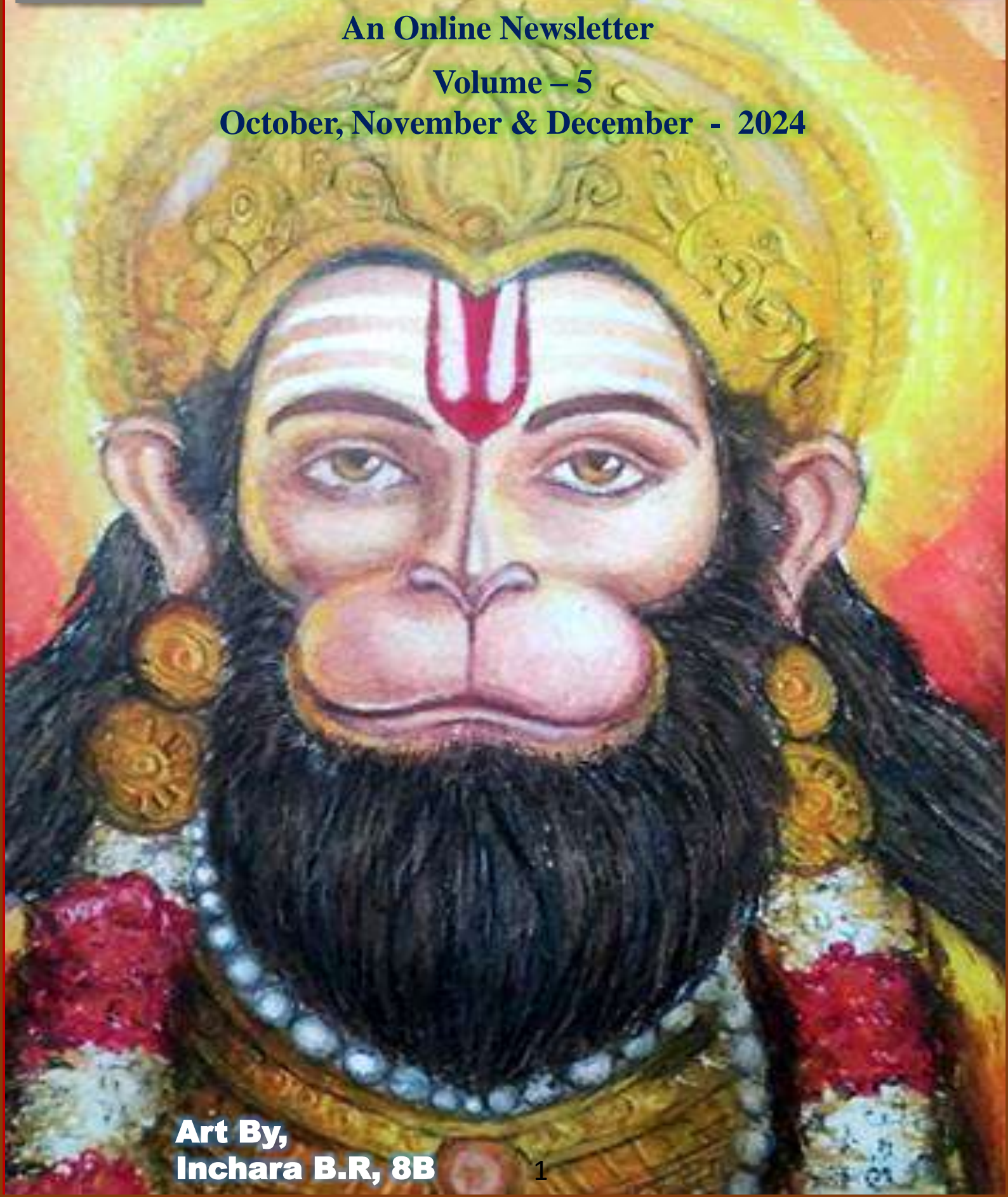

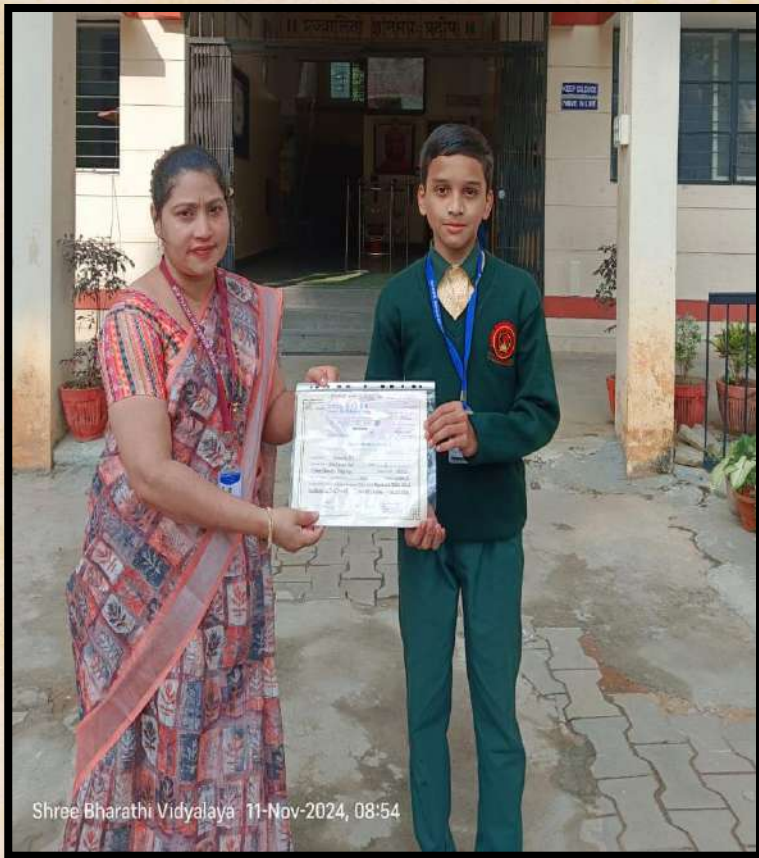

Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam

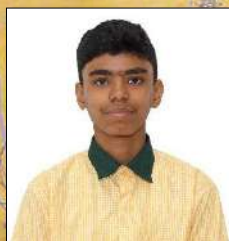

October 15th of every year is celebrated as youth awakening day or world students' day honoring the role of students in shaping our future. The theme of the World Youth Day 2024 is Empowering Students to be agents of change. We celebrate this day on the birthday of Dr APJ Abdul Kalam. Dr APJ Abdul Kalam was elected as the 11th president of India in 2002. Dr Kalam was born in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu. He studied physics and aerospace engineering and became an ISRO scientist who played a pivotal role in the success of India's space missions. His contributions helped significantly in the development of the missiles, Agni and Prithvi and his help was vital in the launch of the satellite Rohini. Dr Kalam lead the Integrated Guided Missile Development Program (IGMDP) which helped in establishing India as a strong contender in missile technology. His efforts in the development of these missiles earned him the title 'Missile Man of India'.

Dr Kalam earned his aerospace degree from the Madras institute of technology in Chennai. His work laid the foundation for the development of defense and space technology of India. When he was elected as the president of India in 2002, his main focus was youth engagement, innovation and education. He often inspired many students across the country with his vision of a developed India. Dr APJ Abdul Kalam wrote several books such as 'Wings of Fire', 'Ignited minds' and 'Indomitable spirit which inspired many young minds by giving insight about his own life and sharing his vision of our country. His vision for the youth of the country was evident as he gave many lectures and speeches at many institutions. He was awarded many honors and awards such as the Bharat Ratna, one of the most prestigious awards given to any citizen of India.

One of Dr Kalam's favourite activities was engaging with children. He travelled across the country, visiting schools, colleges, and universities, answering students' questions, and motivating them to dream big. These interactions are remembered as some of his most heartwarming moments, and they left a lasting impact on many young minds. His legacy will forever be remembered for his passion for the country and the youth.

Shivaram Karanth

"The land does not belong to anyone. It belongs to those who understand its soul and respect its life." – Shivaram Karanth

Shivaram Karanth, a stalwart of Kannada literature, was more than just a writer—he was a thinker, environmentalist, and cultural revivalist who understood the complex connection between humans and nature. This quote from *Chomana Dudi* encapsulates his worldview, emphasizing the respect and admiration we must have for the earth and its resources.

Shivaram Karanth, born on October 10, 1902, in the town of Kota in Karnataka's Udupi district, is a towering figure in Kannada literature and a multifaceted genius. He was born to **Rao Bahadur Shivaram Karanth** and **Saraswati Karanth**, who instilled in him a love for literature and arts from an early age. His contributions extend far beyond literature, reaching areas such as environmental activism, theatre, and education. Widely regarded as one of the greatest Kannada writers, Karanth's distinguished career earned him the prestigious Jnanpith Award, India's highest literary honour. His work reflects a profound engagement with the cultural, social, and environmental fabric of India, with a particular focus on his home state, Karnataka. Karanth's literary journey began in the early 20th century when he was deeply influenced by the socio-political climate of India. His writings reflect the complexities of rural life, the struggles of marginalized communities, and the rich cultural heritage of Karnataka. With over 45 novels, numerous short stories, and plays to his name, Karanth's work is marked by its depth, insight, and a profound understanding of human nature. His writings often drew from folk traditions, incorporating elements of mythology and local lore, thereby preserving the cultural heritage of Karnataka.

Shivarama Karanth's remarkable career earned him several prestigious awards, highlighting his profound influence on Kannada literature and society. In 1977, he was bestowed with the **Jnanpith Award**, India's most esteemed literary honour, recognizing his exceptional literary contributions, particularly through works such as *Mookajjiya Kanasugalu* and *Chomana Dudi*, which addressed pressing social issues of the time. Earlier, in 1968, Karanth had received the **Padma Bhushan**, one of the country's highest civilian accolades. However, in a bold statement of protest against government policies impacting the environment, he returned the award, underscoring his deep commitment to ecological advocacy.

Karanth's accomplishments were further celebrated with honours like the **Karnataka Sahitya Academy Award** and the **Karnataka Rajyotsava Award**, solidifying his status as a cultural beacon in the state of Karnataka.

As we look back on the life and legacy of Shivaram Karanth, his values and insights remain as relevant as ever, encouraging us to foster a deeper respect for our cultural roots and the natural world around us. Karanth was far more than just a writer—he was a visionary who grasped the intricate bonds between people, culture, and the environment. His immense contributions to Kannada literature, along with his tireless dedication to social and environmental causes, have left a lasting imprint on Indian society.

One of his most ambitious projects was the launch of the Tata Nano in 2008, aimed at providing an affordable car for the masses.
