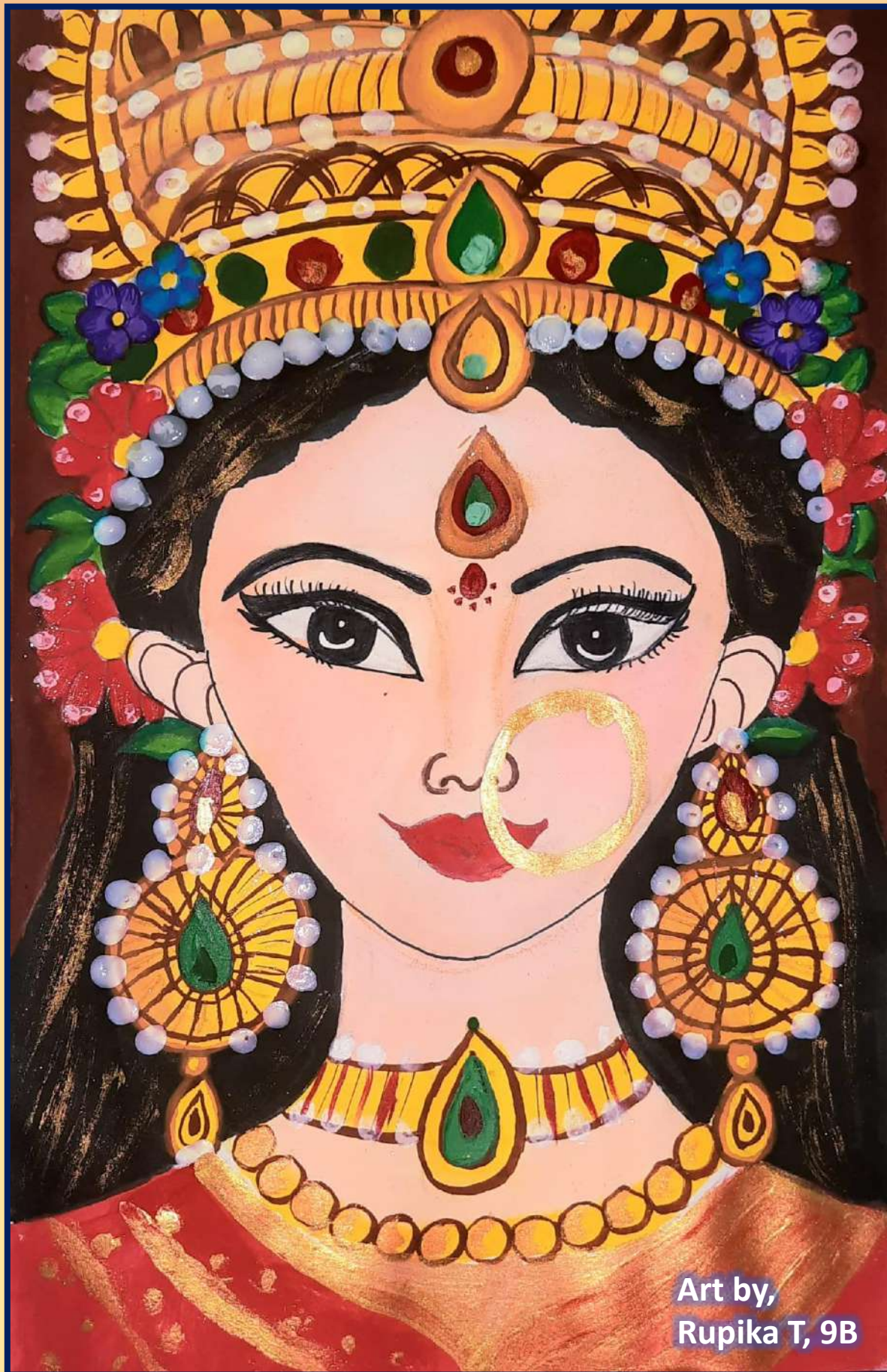

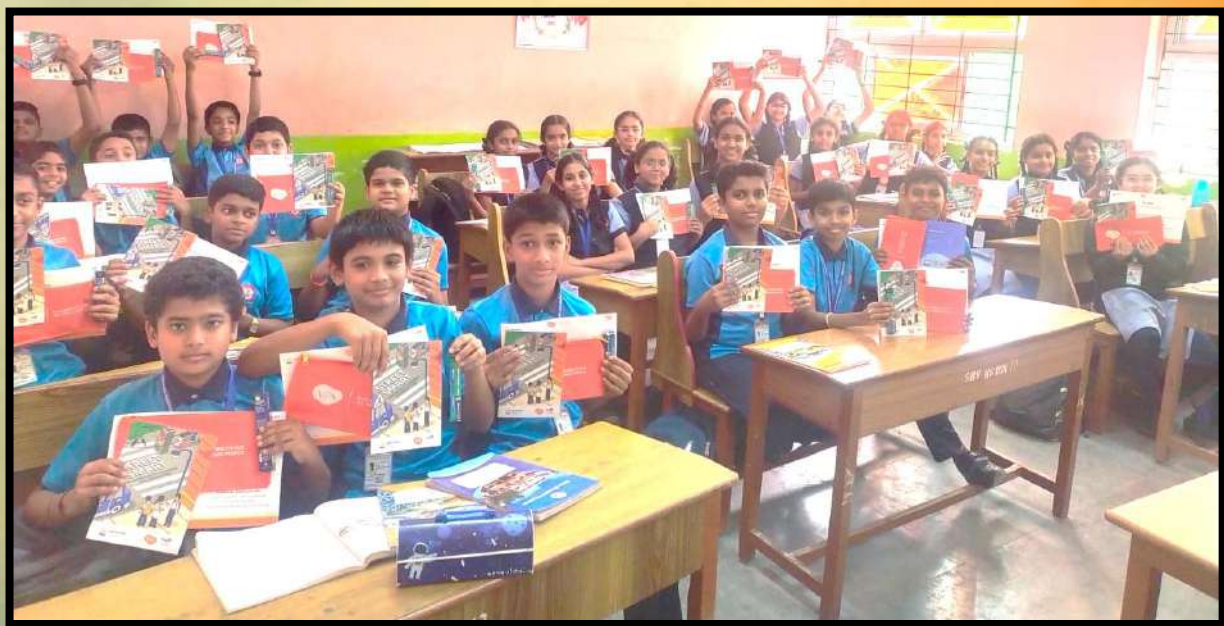


ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS
